

Aim of the programme

Are you managing and protecting the valuable information assets of your organisation?

Information is critical to the operation of your business and Information Security is now a key challenge for managers and engineers world wide who need to meet the legal, contractual and compliance requirements and to deal with the increasing level of internal and external threats.

ISO27001 is the international standard which defines the requirements for an Information Security Management System. The standard is designed to ensure the selection of adequate and proportionate security controls, which will help businesses to protect their information assets and give confidence to their customers.

As a result of attending this course, delegates will:

- Understand the benefits to be gained from implementing ISO 27001
- Be able to explain in outline the coverage of the standard
- Understand the structure of the standard
- Be able to explain what is intended by the risk based approach
- Understand the management system elements
- Be capable of constructing an outline plan for implementation of the standard in their own organisation
- Identify the key roles of implementers and their responsibilities



Who is the course for?

This one day awareness course is intended for people who are in a decision making role in terms of Information Security Management and for potential implementers who require an overview of the standard in order to gain an insight to the benefits to be gained and effort needed to implement ISO 27001.

Content

The course includes the following core themes:

- ISO 27000 family of standards
- ISO 27001 Overview
- Information Security Management Systems explained
- Risk Management
- ISO 27001 controls
- Implementation planning
- The certification process
