

Aim of the programme

Environmental Management is a key requirement for all organizations and suppliers of products and services now include environmental management alongside the fundamental business controls of quality and cost.



This one-day environmental management training course provides an overview of environmental management systems. It has been designed for Engineers who want to understand how environmental policies and best practice can enhance their business.

As a result of attending this course, delegates will be able to:

- Describe the purpose of an environmental management system and explain the legislative framework relevant to an EMS
- Explain the purpose and intent of the ISO 14000 series of standards
- Describe the ISO 14001 requirements
- Understand how an environmental management system works.

Who is the course for?

This course is designed for individuals who need to learn about the 2004 version of ISO 14001. It is appropriate for those with little existing knowledge about the ISO14001 series and is indispensable for those operating or planning to operate an ISO 14001 based system.

Content

The course includes the following core themes:

- Awareness raising on environmental issues
- The purpose of an EMS in managing environmental aspects and impacts
- The relevance to business of environmental management and sustainable development
- Environmental legislation relevant to pollution control in air, on land and in water
- The purpose of the ISO 14000 series and the benefits of using ISO 14001
- The structure and scope of ISO 14001 and key environmental definitions
- The detail of ISO 14001 and possible ways of satisfying the requirements

Structure of the programme

This is a one day course that will consist of presentations, led discussion and short workshop sessions. No prior knowledge of ISO 14001:2015 or environmental management is assumed.
